Dear Applicant:

On June 15, 2015 you notified the Internal Revenue Service of your intent to terminate your foundation status as a private foundation under Section 507(b)(1)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and become a public charity. In our letter of September 17, 2015, we stated that you would be treated as a public charity until the expiration of your 60-month advance ruling period.


Based on the information you submitted at the end of the advance ruling period, we determined that you have terminated your private foundation status under the provisions of Section 507(b)(1)(B) of the Code. Accordingly, as of November 1, 2015 you have been reclassified as a public charity described in Sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) of the Code. Since your exempt status wasn't under consideration, you continue to be classified an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.
