Hello,

We are so excited to have an opportunity to introduce your child/children to the magic of horses and to help them develop leadership skills through horsemanship.

Please have your children wear protective footwear of some sort like hiking boots. If you don't have appropriate shoes - not to worry we can provide boots. Students should wear loose fitting long pants, comfortable tops (that aren't too revealing), sun block, hats for sun protection, sunglasses and **please bring water**.

Please bring your signed **Release of Liability** and **Registration form** to give to your instructor. No student will be able to participant without these signed forms. Drivers are asked to stay at the ranch during session, unless permission is given to leave and return.

Directions for Maddi's Friesian Ranch, 310 Allerman Lane, Gardnerville, NV 89460:

Coming from Town: Take Mottsville Lane west towards the mountains. When you are almost to the end of Mottsville Lane, a tenth of a mile before the Kingsbury Grade intersection, turn right on to Old Foothill Rd.

Coming from Tahoe: At the bottom of Kingsbury Grade, cross over Foothill Road. Make the first left turn, which is only a tenth of a mile from the intersection, onto Old Foothill Road.

Take Old Foothill a 1/4 mile, and turn right onto Allerman Lane, which is dirt. Go almost to end of Allerman and turn left at the **second driveway** of 310 Allerman Lane. There is a black gate which says "Maddi's Friesian Ranch". When you get to the gate you need to push the code **88**.

Please drive 10 mph on Allerman Lane and in the ranch area.

If you have any problems or questions, **call Barbara's cell – 775-309-3879**. Once through the gate drive to and park near, the large outdoor riding arena whose fence is green. Then walk to front of barn.
